



Job Description: Dock Service Labourer

Reports to: Dock Service Manager

Purpose:

The Dock Service Labourer is responsible for performing a variety of tasks in order to assist with the installation/removal of docks and boat lifts, and assorted service of marine related products.

Job Summary – THE 3R's

Role:

Dock Service Labourer

Responsibility:

- Perform as team player with focus on optimism and passion.
- Efficiently complete dock service work according to plan, with focus on quality and production, customer service and satisfaction.

Result:

• Quality dock service work is completed while growing in skill and professionalism, in a positive team environment.

Metrics to Measure Results:

Success within this position will be measured by:

• Performance - Reviews conducted every trimester by direct supervisor.

Detail Overview of Responsibilities:

- 1. Positive Team Player
- Work safely and in a responsible manner, with eager participation and initiative.
- Demonstrate continuous growth through personal goal achievement.
- Demonstrate active participation in regular team meetings
- Comply with all company policies and regulations and local health and safety regulations
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment at all times
- Communicate to customer in polite and courteous manner
- Maintain standards of cleanliness and organization in assigned trucks, trailers, equipment, jobsites, and shop/yard areas





2. Efficiently Produce Work

- Assist crew with the following tasks:
 - a) Install and remove aluminum pipe, floating and tower dock systems.
 - b) Install boat lifts and marine rail systems
 - c) Perform service work as required, adjusting dock heights or alignment
 - d) Load and unload materials, tools, and equipment required to installations
 - e) Transport materials with dollies, floating devices, and hand lifting/carrying
- Operate various tools and equipment, including: chainsaw winch, drills and floating devices
- Maintain standards of cleanliness and organization in assigned trucks, trailers, equipment, jobsites, and shop/yard areas
- Perform preventative maintenance on tools and equipment by conducting inspections, lubricating, and cleaning on a daily basis
- Read and interpret installation manuals, site layout drawings, and contract specifications to perform work activities
- Demonstrate shoreline stewardship with environmental best practices and technical knowledge

3. Seasonal Duties

Note, peak dock service is during spring and early fall. In off peak (mid-summer, late fall), it may be required for this position to participate in landscape construction duties (see separate job description).

Minimum Qualifications and Educational Requirements:

1. High School Diploma, GED or equivalent

Work Conditions:

- Ability to work with hand tools, power tools, small engine equipment, heavy equipment, and materials
- Ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs. repeatedly through an entire work shift
- Ability to work in a fast paced environment
- Excellent stamina is required
- Work near heavy equipment and other vehicles on a regular basis
- Work outdoors in various conditions including heat and humidity, rain, dust, noise, and cold
- Flexible working hours including occasional weekend work
- Work on difficult shoreline access, steep embankments
- Work in water in a variety of conditions, including waves, wind, cold and deep water, and potential ice
- Work occasionally from boat, barge, or other marine equipment.
